Role purpose

As a member of the Instructor Development Programme your role will involve participating in a wide range of tasks and centre based roles. These include assisting to run water and shore based activity programmes, centre front of house duties (reception), acting as duty officer, keeping the centre clean and tidy and assisting in the maintenance of the centres equipment.

Main duties

- As part of your personal development programme you will assist to run water and land based courses both on and offsite in accordance with the programme requirements and Operational Handbook.
- To act as evening duty officer as required
- To act as Night Duty Officer as required
- To assist and support the centres maintenance programme working under the supervision of the Duty Activity Manager and undertaking the designated weekly, monthly and yearly critical checks
- To assist the Equipment Officers when on Centre Work with minor repairs to the instructional department's equipment.
- To assist the Centres Maintenance Officer with minor repairs, grounds work and other duties.
- To assist the administrative team by providing cover on reception as and when required.

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- To respond to any emergency situations and record all incidents and accidents as required with the support of the centres management team.
- Assist the Chief Instructor and the Duty Activity Manager to ensure that waterfront and land based activity operations comply with the centres operation handbook/guidelines and statutory requirements and relevant codes of practice.
- In accordance with the provisions of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, to take reasonable care for the health and safety of yourself and others who may be affected by your acts or omissions at work. To co-operate with Sports Wales in compliance with its duties under any health and safety provisions, e.g. undertake risk assessments, COSHH/HACCP assessments, etc.
- To wear the appropriate uniform and comply with any customer service initiatives and dealing with customer comments and related procedures.
- To provide assistance to other Sport Wales' staff consistent with ensuring that the operational requirements of the Centre are met.
- To help maintain a tidy and hygienic environment in all areas of the Centre (internal and external).
- The nature of the post is such that the post holder is required to work irregular and unsocial hours including evenings, nights, weekends and bank, public and other nominated holidays. Work patterns will require reasonable flexibility in accordance with the needs of the Centre.
- Fulfil responsibilities which contribute to delivering an exemplary service for Sport Wales in respect of our statutory duties, including Well-being of Future Generations (Wales), Equality, Information Security, Risk Management, Safeguarding, Financial Regulation and Health, Safety & Environment.
- Work flexibly, performing any other duties as required, where relevant to the post and appropriate to the grade.
